About NPDCSNJ:

In the business of "doing good," the question of what it takes to be a great organization is often unasked and unanswered. Executive directors must be resourceful in meeting the needs of their constituents, generating enough income to keep programs running and accomplish all of the above while keeping board members engaged and informed.
