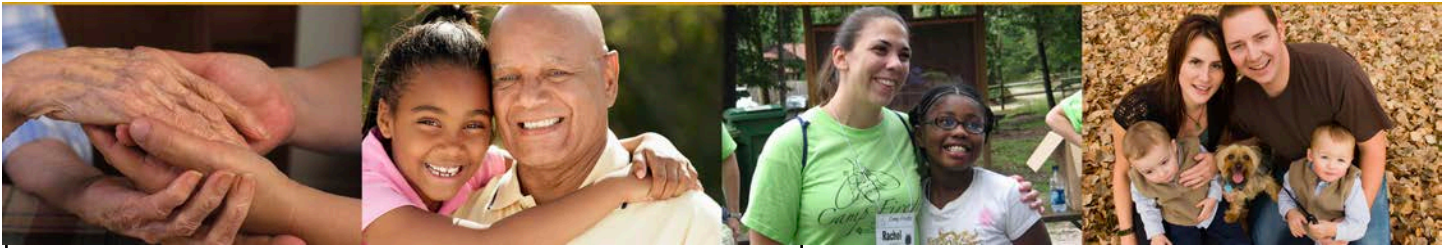

The children who have lost a parent, sibling or other special person through death, Camp Firefly provides a special place to share feelings, to make new friends, and to find comfort and joy. Throughout the camp weekend, activities designed to help them deal with continuing grief, including experiences such as learning, painting, crafts, and role-plays. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and for the safety of our campers, volunteers and staff, Camp Firefly 2020 will be postponed and the dates have not yet been set for 2021.

At the end of August each year, registered child will receive a Free one-on-one "Camp in a Box" filled with handout materials and information received on understanding their grief, processing their emotional responses, and finding positive coping skills by the future. Some examples of the materials included are a memorial poster that the camper will design and sign with a self-design, personalized apron, an invitation card that will allow them to express their memories, feelings, and wisdom, activities that will help them open up to their counselor through the
